




How will they ever know who they are?




Research reveals that: not only expected tangible rewards made contingent on task performance, but also threats, deadlines, directives, pressured evaluations, and imposed goals, reliably undermine intrinsic motivation.



THE POWER OF INTRINSIC MOTIVATION


Comparisons between people who are intrinsically motivated and those who are extrinsically motivated reveal that the former have more interest, excitement and confidence and that this leads to: enhanced performance, persistence, creativity, heightened vitality, self-esteem and general wellbeing. (Ryan & Deci)










I enjoy this feeling (metaphorically) and look forward to the new flames, and I really can't wait until the flames become a blaze!"






